



Results:

- Readings between (0-15%) - no cause for concern. *10 10 24*
- Readings between (16-20%) - may require further investigation. Recommend recheck the affected area in 3 months.
- Readings between (21-30%) - moisture evident possible remedial work required; may not need stripdown unless surface damage (staining, pimpling, softness) is apparent. (There may be a risk of wallboard deterioration due to retained moisture in structure if resealed only.)
- Readings (31% and above) - Possible structural damage may be occurring. Full stripdown of the affected area is recommended to ascertain level of repair required.
